"When I heard that Kirby was going to be performing in North Carolina, I bought a ticket and gassed up the car for the trip from Philadelphia. The location (Concord) was chosen because it is the home town of Sarah Morgann, who shares the bill with Kirby and pianist Marvin Goldstein. The performance was held at the local High School, but I can't imagine a more polished and professional show.

We all know and appreciate Kirby's talent, but his fellow performers were no less wonderful. Sarah Morgann has a beautiful, clear, bell-like voice that is breathtaking, and Brother Goldstein is an accomplished and celebrated pianist, as evidenced by the many albums he has released. (More than Kirby, but as Kirby will not let him forget, he is much older). What is more, They both have humor and stage presence the equal of Kirby's, even with our guy not only performing, but also acting as MC, and generally amping up the "Kirbyness" of the whole show. Marvin Goldstein has a wonderful, dry sense of humor, while the lovely Sarah Morgann seems to float above with an ethereal grace, even when cast as the prima dona in the gibberish opera "Making Snowballs with Yellow Snow" (Composer: K. Heyborne, Libretto by the Swedish Chef from The Muppets).

The show opens with some Christmas classics, performed in a light-hearted manner. I warn you ahead of time--be prepared for audience participation. There are a couple numbers where Kirby drags people up on stage, both for a "Finish that Christmas Carol" segment, and a "12 days of Christmas" that has to be experienced to be believed. The playful tone is modulated somewhat after the intermission, with another wonderful medley by Marvin Goldstein, an a capella song by Sarah Morgann, and Kirby singing a heartfelt "Angels We Have Heard on High", all finished off with some more carols with the audience joining in.

So if you're anywhere in the general region--GO!!!! I made a 1200 mile round trip, and I consider it well worth it."
